

Clergy will also be available to hear confessions at 1:00 Monday through Thursday during Holy Week (April 14 through April 17), and from 1:00 to 3:00 on Good Friday (April 18). If you would like to have your confession heard, wait in the pews near the baptismal font and you will be brought to the chapel by a priest. At the beginning of the service, the priest will usually walk the penitent through the service. The Sacrament of Reconciliation rarely takes more than ten minutes.
